- ❖ Assistant General Manager (SLBC) welcomed all the Govt. officials and participants of various Banks. He thanked the Principal Secretary (Tourism) for releasing subsidy of Rs. 5.21 Crores since last SLBC meeting. He further requested that the remaining subsidy due of around Rs. 7 Crores may also be released at the earliest.

- ❖ Principal Secretary (Tourism), Shri Rakesh Sharma advised SLBC to arrange details for latest subsidy due figures of all the banks so that remaining subsidy may be paid at the earliest. SLBC convener ensured that this figure shall be called from all Lead District Managers and shall be submitted to Tourism Deptt. at the earliest.
- ❖ Principal Secretary (Tourism) advised that there are some irregularities in sanctioning/disbursement of loans by some banks in Pauri Distt and wanted an enquiry in sanctioning/disbursement under this scheme. He also advised that District Magistrate Pauri has suspended District Tourism Officer already due to these irregularities.
- ❖ The Industry Deptt was again advised to prepare one/two Model projects for each Distt. considering prevailing conditions at the district viz. availability of Raw material, Demand & Supply position and so on so that bank may finance that industry in the concerned district under Credit Guarantee Fund Trust scheme.
- ❖ Convener (SLBC) advised that loan sanctioned by banks in Uttarakhand under CGFT scheme during 2009-10 was Rs. 98.75 Crores which appears quite satisfactory. However, banks are requested to further expedite sanction of loans under this scheme during current financial year.
- ❖ In view of providing Banking facility at identified Atal Adarsh Villages and villages having population of over 2000, the Banks requested Govt. of Uttarakhand, to allot space at concerned Nyay Panchayats for opening of Branch or placing Business Correspondent (where ever required) and to arrange Broad Band connectivity at all identified villages from BSNL. Principal Secretary & Commissioner (Infrastructure) Shri Joshi advised that banks may put such specific demands in this regard to GoU for taking up matter with concerned department/BSNL.
